Re: Response to Provisions in Water Use License TYPE "B" FOR CAM-F SITE INVESTIGATION

The Department of Environment (DOE), Government of Nunavut has reviewed the Response to Provisions in Water Use License, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), Nunavut". This report was submitted to the NWB under INAC current water license, Part F, Item 2.

Comments/Recommendations:

- The proponent should provide a site map showing the location of different facilities on site including fuel storage facilities and chemical storage, and the location of spill kits. A description of the storage facility is also important for persons unfamiliar with the facility or area.
- 2) It is important to provide accurate amounts of materials (fuels, chemicals etc.) stored on site for the safety of the workers, and it would allow the company or organization to accurately determine the amount of material lost in the event of a spill. MSDS for each product or contaminant stored at your facility
- 3) The proponent should provide contact names, job titles, and 24-hour telephone number for the persons in charge, management or control. This would be the onsite personnel responsible for managing the facility and activating the spill contingency plan in the event of a spill.
- 4) An inventory and location of response and clean up equipment available to implement the plan. This will include all equipment that will be used by you or on your behalf.
- 5) The proponent should provide a description of training to employees for clean up procedures and spill response.
