UMA Engineering Ltd. is pleased to submit this annual report as per the requirements of Part B.1 of Water Use License #NWB5SHE0510. The report was prepared on behalf of Defence Construction Canada and the Department of National Defence.

Equipment and materials were mobilized to the CAM-3 site in September 2005. The work involved construction of the camp facilities and setting of survey control points in preparation of the 2006 season. The camp was operational for one month. In that time, approximately 36 cubic metres of water was extracted from the water supply lake. Approximately 29 cubic metres of effluent was discharged into the sewage lagoon; no samples were collected.

Two photographs are attached showing the camp set up and the hangar interior, where equipment is currently being stored.

There were no spill incidences reported at the CAM-3 site in 2005.

The work plan for 2006 will be to continue with the clean up activities as described in the project description. An overall site plan is included to show the locations of the various work areas described in this report.
