The Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND) is submitting applications for the Phase III environmental site assessment of the former CAM-D (Simpson Lake) Intermediate DEW Line Site. CAM-D (Simpson Lake) is located 80 km west of Pelly Bay and 120 km southeast of Taloyoak. Due to the fact that the Akunniq Land Use Plan has not been developed, a Nunavut Planning Commission conformity check will not be completed.

DIAND has submitted applications for a Land Use Permit through the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development, a Water License through the Nunavut Water Board and a Land and Water Research License through the Nunavut Research Institute.
