RE: Water Board Licence No. 1BR-STU1318: Landfarm on CAM-A Project Site

This is an addendum to our letter of February 19, 2014 titled "Water Board Licence No. 1BR-STU1318 Amendment Request – CAM-A (Sturt Point) Site Remediation Project". This addendum concerns the methodology for the construction and operation of Landfarm on CAM-A site and the justification for non-requirement of monitoring wells around the landfarm facility. Please find the proposed methodology in the attached memo prepared by our consultant (AECOM).

We successfully operated similar landfarms in single (construction) season (6 weeks or at most 10 weeks in other locations in Nunavut). The ground surface will be fully compacted and if the desired compaction cannot be achieved, a liner will be placed over the ground before placing the contaminated soils, to prevent migration of contaminants from the soil to the ground beneath (*please see more details in the attached memo*).
