

The project involves the installation of a crossing on the Duval River to allow transportation of crushed rock from an existing quarry to the existing harbour. The truck route will utilize an existing road network. The river crossing will be made up of 3 culverts of the following size – 40 metres long by 1.8 metres in diameter. Fill to support the crossing will be placed on the river bed and around the culverts will require 3,500 cubic metres of crushed rock. The construction of the crossing will be started during the construction season of 2009 and will remain in place to support the construction of the Pangnirtung Small Craft Harbour.
