Dear Hamlet of Pangnirtung SAO and Bhabesh Roy:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed the technical review of the 2018 and 2019 Annual Reports (2018 Report and 2019 Report, respectively) (Reports) for Type “B” Water Licence 1BW-DUV1520 (Licence). The 2018 Report was received on March 27, 2019, and the 2019 Report was received on March 30, 2020 from the Hamlet of Pangnirtung (Hamlet or Licensee) and submitted as a requirement under Part B of the Licence.

The NWB distributed the 2018 Report and 2019 Report to the Qikiqtani distribution list for information on March 27, 2019 and March 30, 2020, respectively. No comments have been received to date.

The Board notes that both Reports are missing data collected from Monitoring Program Stations DUV-1 and DUV-2 as required under Part H of the Licence. The provided lab analyses results appear to pertain to another water licence that the Hamlet currently holds for a Municipal Undertaking. In addition, the NWB could not locate annual reports for 2014 and 2017. Finally, the NWB reminds the Licensee that, in accordance to Part F, Item 1 and Part G, Item 1 of the Licence, the Hamlet was required to submit the updated Abandonment and Restoration Plan and Spill Contingency Plan by August 8, 2015. To date, the NWB does not have a record of receiving the updated versions of the Plans. Therefore, the Board requests that the Licensee provide the missing information on or before **June 30, 2020**.

The Board would also like to remind the Licensee that the Licence expires on June 8, 2020.
