The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted proposal:

- 1. Construction of residential road link about 50m long, with culvert, using gravel from existing quarry.
- 2. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Gjoa Haven]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this proposal falls within the exemption of certain works and activities from the definition of the term "project" under the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NUPPAA)* and from the definition of the term "project proposal" under the *Nunavut Agreement*. The NPC only has a statutory mandate to review "projects/project proposals". As such, the proposal is exempt from a review by the NPC and screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB).
