Southampton Island Caribou Harvest

The Nunavut Water Board has received an application for a licence dated January 26, 1998, from Tunniq Harvest Ltd. for a caribou harvest project on Southampton Island. The application includes the construction of temporary camps and storage of material on the surface of ice of lakes, and the use of water and deposit of waste for the portable abattoir, which were not part of the original land use permit application.

The project was screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board, and a screening determination was sent to the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada. A copy of the project description, screening report and related correspondence was already provided to you by NIRB.

NIRB's screening decision dated January 22, 1998 stipulates "<u>that Tunnuq Harvest Ltd. contact</u> the Nunavut Water Board regarding potential water use permit that may be required for water use the placement of the camp on the surface of the lake ice".
