FOX-A is located on Bray Island approximately 170 km northeast of the community of Hall Beach and 175 km east of the community of Igloolik. It is situated at Latitude 69° 13' N and Longitude 77° 14' W. FOX-A was a former Intermediate Distant Early Warning Line site operational from 1957 until 1963. The remediation of this site will be funded under the Federal Contaminated Sites Action Plan.
