

- 4. Q. Can you confirm whether or not residents of Taloyoak do commercial fishing on the lake where indicator minerals will be doing their drilling. A . No
- 5. Can you confirm that the area of barrow lake project is where fuel drum have been left and the area has been unreclaimed. A. Yes the same Company (Indicator Minerals ) have left fuel drums on the Grail Property just 70 km northwest of Taloyoak as attached information on Developing Projects Grail. Hunters from Taloyoak have seen empty fuel drums around the Grail Project.
