**Subject:**    Twin Mining Corporation – Jackson Inlet Project, Renewal

Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) received on May 26, 2004 your referral of Twin Mining Corporations request for renewal of their water licence for exploration activities associated with the Jackson Inlet Project.

At the time of the initial submission DFO had provided comments to the proponent for the exploration program for the Jackson Inlet Project. Upon review of the most recent submission DFO understands that the proposed activities have not substantially changed since the previous water licence was granted. However, it is understood that drilling activities will be undertaken under a separate water licence to be obtained by Kennecott Canada Exploration Inc. Since the project does not appear to have changed significantly, the original letter of advice to the proponent would still apply as appropriate to both Twin Mining Corporation and Kennecott Canada Exploration Inc. for their portions of the proposed work.
