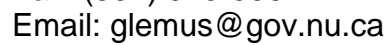
The spill contingency plan was revised due to the limited amount of information provided in the original plan. For the most part, the plan contains all of the components that a spill contingency plan would require. However, in order to complete the plan a site map should be included, showing where all of the buildings, equipment, and materials are located in case of an emergency. The site map would also allow for a faster response time in the event that a spill should occur.
