On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed True North Gems Inc.'s letter to the Nunavut Water Board regarding the EC concerns with the information submitted in their Type B licence application (letter dated March 22, 2006). The proponent's information satisfies EC's concerns regarding the disposal of drill water, the establishment of culverts, and the revision of its project's spill contingency plan. Environment Canada reminds the proponent that at all times it must meet the provisions of Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act* when disposing of any drilling wastes.

Environment Canada is appreciative of the proponent's willingness to maintain open dialogue with federal regulators throughout this environmental assessment process and looks forward to learning of its progress in the Beluga Sapphire Project.
