During April 2011, Kikiak Contracting Ltd. (Kugluktuk) had a crew clean up the camp site of fuel drums, tents and equipment as much as was possible. Fuel drums and wood were removed from site and transported to the Mouse Lake camp operated by Hornby Bay Exploration Ltd. in the Dismal Lakes area. Tents and other equipment were removed from site and transported to Kikiak's yard in Kugluktuk. Hornby Bay was to have a team of its personnel clean the camp site once the snow had left. However, this did not take place so alternative clean up plans were put in place during 2012.
