Western Uranium would like to amend its Water License to allow core drilling in Prospecting Permits 6885 and 6886 as part of our 2007 work program. The locations of this proposed drilling are shown on Figure 3.1, which is attached to this letter. It is our intention to comply with all terms and commitments as outlined for previously proposed drilling in Prospecting Permit 6893, referenced as G7SW in Figure 3.0 in our original application. This amendment would reassign some of the permitted ten holes from G7SW to the new area. Subject to approval of this amendment, we hope to commence the reassigned drilling by September 1, 2007 with completion of our entire field program by September 30.

We are also providing this information to INAC in accordance with the terms of their permit.
