Hello Phyllis,

During the past month, the NIRB has received several requests from the Nunavut Water Board for screening decisions on new Class B Water License Applications. The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) has requested that "if the project is exempt from screening pursuant to Schedule 12-1 of the NLCA, the NWB requests written confirmation from the NIRB that the project proposal is in fact exempt from screening". According to Section 12-1 (2) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement which states "Land use activities requiring only a Class B permit under the *Territorial land Use Regulations*" are Exempt from screening, the above stated projects consist of applications for Class B Water Licenses and are therefore exempt from NIRB screening.
