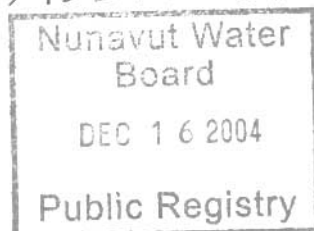

Subject: A request for all NWB2 Licensees to adopt a standardized form for the filing of Annual Reports

Dear Licensees:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") requires that all Licensees, in possession of a NWB2 license for the use of water and disposal of waste associated with mineral exploration camps, submit an Annual Report not later than March 31st of the year following the calendar year reported.

To assist the Licensees in fulfilling their annual reporting obligations, as well as making its own reviews more efficient, the NWB has developed a standardized form that all NWB2 Licensees are required to use for their forthcoming Annual Reports. This requirement is made pursuant to Part B of the NWB2 water license, which states, "*The Licensee shall file an Annual Report on the Appurtenant Undertaking with the Board not later than March 31st of the year following the calendar year reported which shall contain the following information:... Any other details on water use or waste disposal requested by the Board by November 1 of the year being reported*". The NWB considers the use of this standardized form to be such a detail.

The form is now available on the NWB's FTP site at:

The standardized form has been made into an Adobe Acrobat document which permits Licensees to directly fill out the form. However, to save changes made to the form, the Licensee will require the full version of Adobe Acrobat, version 5.0 or higher. The freeware version of Adobe Acrobat, Adobe Reader will permit the Licensees to write in the form, but it does not allow for changes to be saved. Licensees with Adobe Reader do, however, have the option of printing their changes and subsequently faxing the report to the NWB.

Standard Form for Annual Reporting Requirements of NWB2 Mineral Exploration Water Licences

Introduction

Under the terms of water licences issued by the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") for the use of water and the disposal of waste into water associated with mineral exploration (NWB2 licences), licensees are required to submit to the NWB an Annual Report no later than March 31st of the year following the calendar year reported.

In order to aid the licensee with the preparation of the Annual Report and facilitate its review and approval by the NWB, licensees are required to use the following form. Metric units should be used to report any relevant data. If additional space is required, please append one or more sheets to the Annual Report.

Annual Reports shall be submitted by either fax, mail or email (in Microsoft Word or Adobe Acrobat format) to:
