<p>On July 6th the Inspector attended 2 sites listed in the 2010 Application to inspect the short term/ low impact camp and tenting sites associated with the 3BC-LEP1010 Project. Upon arrival at the general location of the camp area the inspector noted that no evidence of occupation or disturbance could be seen. No persons, structures or activities could be seen in the area. The sites were both found in what appeared to be their natural state with no evidence of disturbance.</p> <p>On July 6th the Inspector attended the areas around the sites listed in the application submitted to the Nunavut Water Board. A review of the Nunavut Water Board web site (FTP site) cannot locate an Annual Report for the above noted file. As such the Inspector cannot confirm the locations as listed in the application as those actually visited by the proponent or whether or not any type of camp or overnight facilities were erected at these or other locations</p>

<p>During the period of the Inspection 4 drums of aviation fuel and two drums of heating fuel were found on the beach side area where the strip for the site is located. These drums were found not in secondary containment. It is not clear why these drums were not removed from the camp. The Licensee is required to confirm with PCSP that drums associated with this project were all removed from camp and to have that information included in the above noted Annual Report. The coordinates are as follows: N 78 44 37.4 X W82 30 21.5.</p>
