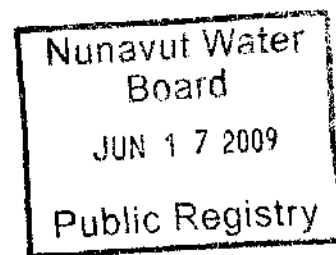

If all NIRB has is the Class B Water License (exempt through Schedule 12-1(5)) and the CLEY Archaeology Permit (exempt through a Schedule 12-1(7) agreement), then we would not be screening it.

If the project requires some other authorizations then we may have to reconsider but, for now, if what you have sent is all that your project requires, the NIRB is not triggered for the purposes of screening.
