

38. Abandonment and restoration activities at the site

The first stage of the program will last only two weeks, beginning around April 1. This phase will consist of camp set-up, grid set-up, magnetic surveying and diamond drilling. During this phase, all combustible garbage will be burned in a barrel and returned to Yellowknife at the completion of this first stage. As well, all non-combustible material will be stored in a barrel and shipped out. At the completion of this stage, all drill equipment and empty barrels will be returned to Yellowknife.

The second stage of the program will begin around June 20 and last for four to six weeks. The work will consist of prospecting and mapping. During this time, all combustible garbage will be burned and back filled at the end of the program. At the completion of this phase of the program, all empty barrels, tents and equipment will be flown to Yellowknife.
