Project Overview:

The Navigator Exploration Corporation would like to do mineral exploration at Nowyak Lake. They propose to drill three to six holes at the depth of 300 to 500 metres at Komatic Lake. A baseline and grid will be set up at the Komatic Lake, roughly 2 kilometres northeast of the camp. A twelve-person camp will be set up at the northern tip of Nowyak Lake, which will be setup on April 1st, 1999. Summer operations consist of prospecting, mapping and sampling within a radius of 30 kilometres of base camp.

All garbage will be burned in a barrel and buried in pit. Sewage and gray water will be buried in pit. Drums will be stored 50 to 100 metres from shoreline. Any spillage, which will occur, will be confined to this area and will be dealt with by removal of the contaminated material and burning and burial within the garbage pit. A hand pump will be used to transfer fuel to skidoos etc. Fuel barrels will be transported by skid for use with drilling.

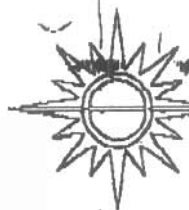

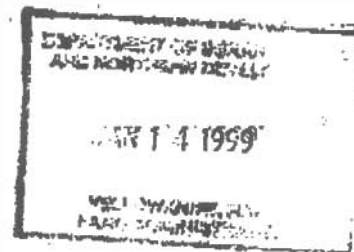

1. A main camp will be set up at the northern tip of Nowrak Lake (see maps) on or around April 1, 1999. Drill and fuel will be mobilized at same time.
2. A baseline and grid will be set up at Komatic Lake, roughly 2 kms northeast of the base camp.
3. Drilling will be performed on a peninsula at Komatic Lake (see map). Between 300-500 metres of drilling (three to six holes) is proposed.
Drill range of 3-5 km
4. Drilling will be completed around 2nd or 3rd week in April at which time all equipment will be demobilized except for tent floor and left-over fuel in drums.
5. Small camp will be remobilized to same camp location on or around June 15-20, 1999.
6. Prospecting will be performed until the end of July 31, 1999.
7. All empty barrels, equipment, personnel will be demobilized to Yellowknife. Wooden tent floor will be burned and buried.

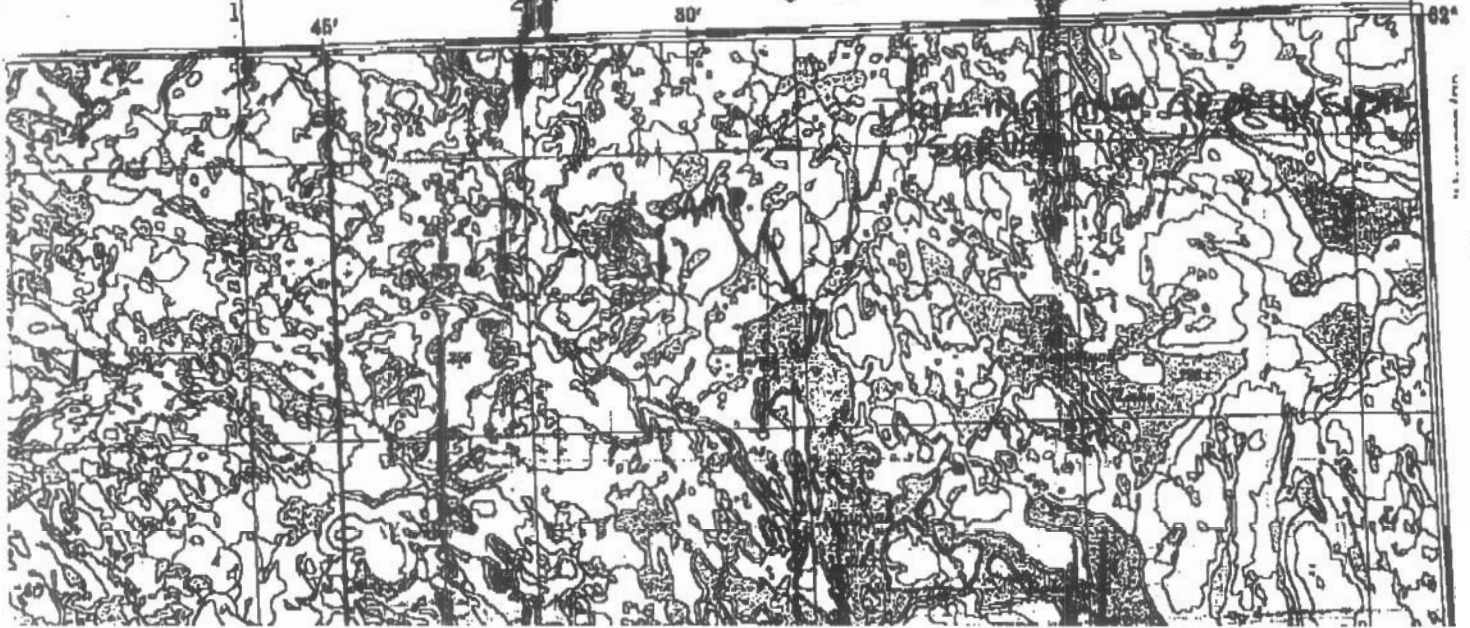

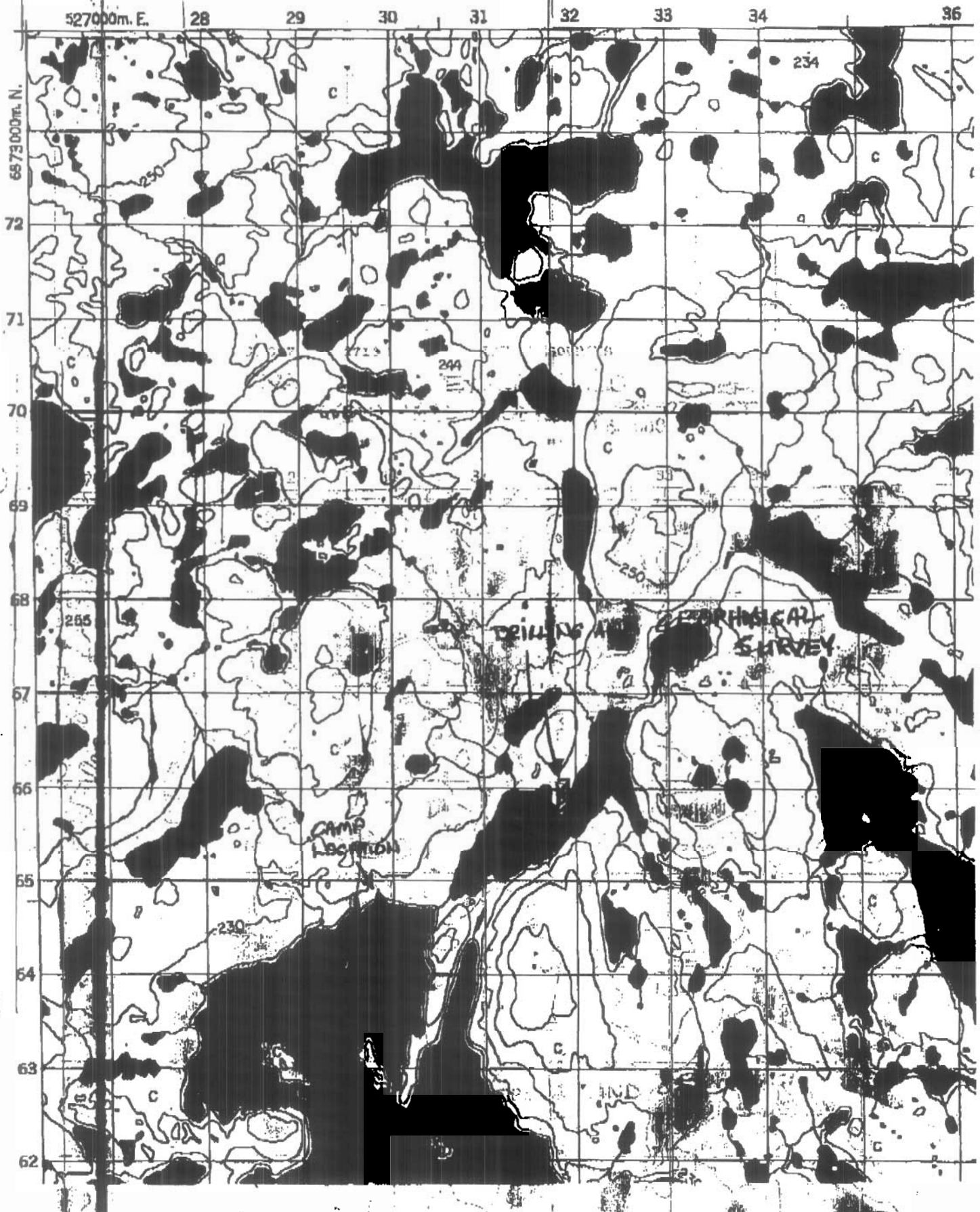
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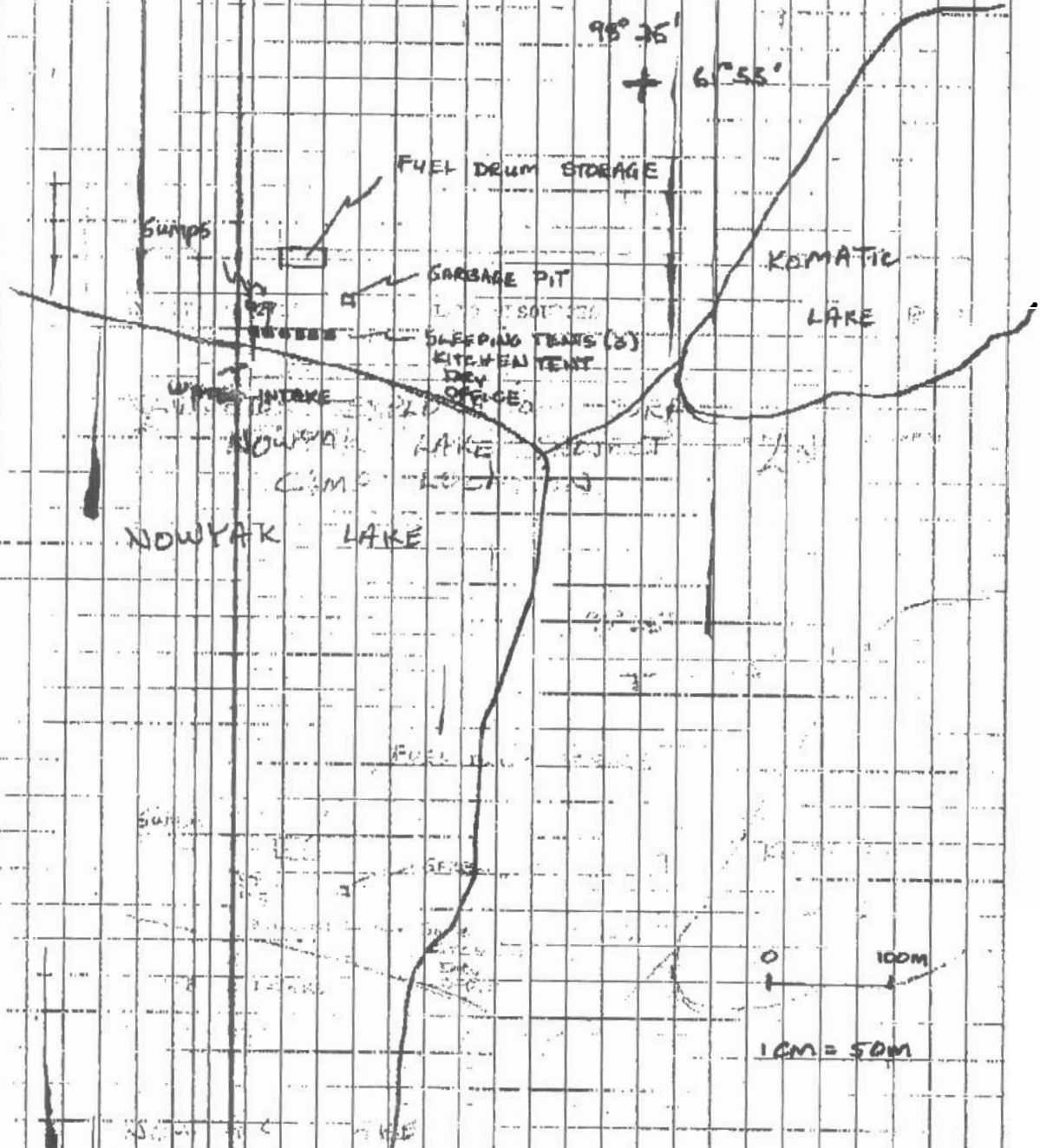


NAVIGATOR EXPLORATION CORP. NOWYAK LAKE PROJECT 1:50 000
