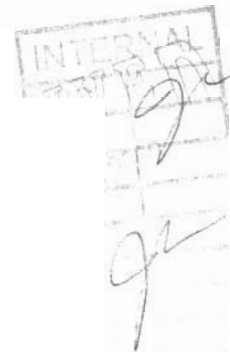
RE: Water Licence Application, University of Tennessee

The Water Resources Division has reviewed the water licence application for the above-mentioned undertaking. Due to the scale and nature of this project, there are no water licence requirements under the NWT Waters Act. Schedule VI of the Act exempts certain activities from Licence requirements, in this case the project is exempt because the camp population will not exceed 50 people and, there is no direct or indirect deposit of waste to surface waters. In addition, the environmental impacts of this project will be addressed by the Kitikmeot Inuit Association Land Use Permits.
