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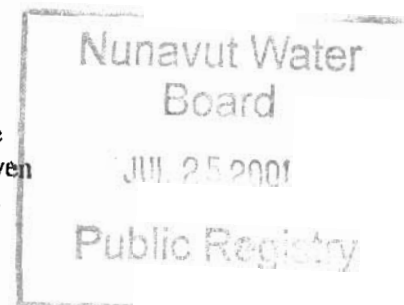

This letter is in response to your July 5th, 2001 correspondence. After review I have concluded that I still require information indicating flow velocity at high water levels, as well as the increase in flow due to the reduction in width of the river due to construction of the abutments (important to ensure fish passage given increased velocity of flow.) As well as calculations indicating the ability of the bridge to withstand this increased flow. If you could provide me with this information, it would be appreciated.
