RE: request of approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence

Qikiqtaaluk operated a hydrocarbon impacted waste water treatment in Iqaluit to provide services to clients that have to manage impacted water/snow during spills or from tank washing.

The impacted water is collected from the site of spills and pumped in reservoir and hauled to our facility in Iqaluit. The water is treated through a separator and then filters and activated carbon cartridges. The treated water is then stored in clean reservoir. The treated water is then sampled and analysed in a certified laboratory to see if it meet the applicable criteria specified in the Government of Nunavut Environmental Guidelines for Industrial Waste Discharges. The results are provided to the GN Department of Environment who then authorize the discharge when criteria are met. Then the city of Iqaluit is called to pump the treated water in the sewage truck and the treated water is then discharge in the municipal sewage system.
