**Water Quality Workshop  
High Lake Project**

Stephanie, Zinifex will be holding a technical workshop relating to the water quality modelling done for the High Lake Project for the information of all interested parties as part of the project's environmental review on May 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, 2008 in Yellowknife NT. Immediately following the water quality workshop, a one-day session covering a Failure Modes and Effects Analysis will be conducted on May 29<sup>th</sup>.

This workshop is being held to fulfil a commitment made at the technical meeting and will provide updated work on the surface and ground water quality and hydrologic simulations computed using GoldSim software. The workshop will be held at the Office Restaurant meeting room at 4915, 50th Street in Yellowknife, NT. Technical information will be distributed to the parties prior to the workshop and the results of the modelling will be presented in the two day session. There will be an opportunities for the parties to provide feedback and input to examine the sensitivity of the natural system to changes in the input parameters to the model.
