The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Winter Road Access:
 - a. Construction of a winter road from Ekati Mine to Jericho Mine.
 - b. INAC will be applying for a Land Use Permit for the Lupin Mine to Jericho Mine portion of the road.
2. Site Cleanup/Remediation:
 - a. Re-establish the natural drainage flow
 - b. Breaching the West Dam and Divider Dyke A
 - c. Covering the Processed Kimberlite Containment Area
 - d. Grading pads and borrow areas
 - e. Excavation and treatment or disposal of contaminated soil
 - f. Building demolition
 - g. Landfill construction
 - h. Disposal of non-hazardous material
 - i. Offsite disposal of hazardous waste
