Hello Phyllis,

We have received the attached proposal/permit application from Kitikmeot Foods Limited. The proposal is to commercially harvest and process muskoxen on Victoria Island, with the operation based out of Cambridge Bay (as in previous years). The project is planned to commence in mid-February.

Also attached are the draft permit conditions that we would attach to the permit.

In previous years there was some question on whether or not a water licence was required as the processing will be taking place within the community. However, we thought it best to submit this to you anyway. I note one item that may be of interest: The proponent intends to dispose of the waste material by dumping it on the land.

If you have any concerns, or suggested changes to make to the licence conditions, let me know. If the company needs to apply for a Water Licence, let me know and we will advise them accordingly.
