Hello Richard:

Further to the issuance of NWB water licence 2BE-ANI0813, North Arrow Minerals is required to submit revised and amended Spill Contingency Plan and Abandonment and Restoration Plan. Earlier this month I prepared extensive revisions to both plans and submitted same to Gordon Clarke of North Arrow Minerals for comments/changes. At that time I was advised that North Arrow's sister company Strongbow Exploration Inc. had cleaned up and completed closed and removed the Rush Lake camp situated on the IOL-portion of the Anialik lands. As a result there is now no camp in existence for the Anialik property and I am having to revise both plans once again to reflect this change.

I hope to have both plans revised and reviewed once again by Gordon sometime this week. As soon as I get the okay from Gordon I will send both plans to you on CD via Priority Post (and via e-mail too). I just wanted to explain why you have not received these 2 revised plans as of today's date.
