## NTI's comments

Taqueray Resources Ltd should hire as much local residents as possible. Any archaeological sites are to be documented and reported to the appropriate agency. All non-combustible garbage or waste to be removed off site and disposed of at an appropriate site. The camp should be located on durable land. Feeding of wildlife is absolutely prohibited. Continuously consult with residents on progress and activity of project.
