Further to the comments and inquiries made concerning the Amendment to the above-referenced Water License, we have the following:

1. Letter of Environment Canada, March 19, 2008, acknowledged.
2. Letter of Environment Canada, May 22, 2008:
  - a) 2008 Bugs Program is a summer program – no drilling through ice.
  - b) Receipt of Environment Canada contact information – acknowledged.
3. Letter of Nunavut Department of Environment, March 17, 2008:
  - a) Drillers (MPH Consulting Ltd. using Boreal Drilling Inc.) will provide standard spill kit. Any spill, after collection, would be shipped to Kasba Lodge (staging location for Bugs camp), and from there sent to licensed disposal facility in Manitoba.
  - b) Camp site map, illustrating facilities, drillsites, etc., to be provided when camp is fully established and drillsites, other facilities are known.
