Re: Licence Application - UR- Energy - 2BE-BUG

On behalf of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND), I have reviewed the additional information submitted by UR - Energy with respect to 2BE-BUG. In reviewing this file, all documents attached in an email sent by Phyllis Beaulieu, received May 15th, 2007, have been considered.

Section 5.4, Other contact for spill response/assistance, of the Spill Contingency Plan should be amended. The proponent is correct in listing Henry Kablalik as the INAC Land Use Inspector, however in the case of a spill Peter Kusugak (manager of Field Operations) is the initial contact for INAC. Furthermore, Philippe di Pizzo is listed under Water Licence Inspection. Mr. di Pizzo, as the former executive director of the Nunavut Water Board, has no formal relationship with water licence inspections. Under the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act INAC is responsible for water licence compliance. Again, Peter Kusugak should be included as an initial contact for INAC.

Section 25 of the Exploration / Remote Camp Supplementary Questionnaire requires the proponent to describe the types, quantities and method(s) of storage of fuel and chemicals on site and provide MSDS sheets. Section 25 states the following substance will be kept on-site: diesel (15 barrels), Jet A (50 barrels) and propane (20 cylinders). Again, INAC requests MSDS sheets be included in the application as an appendix to the Spill Contingency Plan.
