WATER LICENCE INSPECTION REPORT

Cancellation of the above licence was requested by the licensee on August 31, 2012. Five camps were listed in the licence. A final site inspection was requested by the NWB, and this licence was added to AANDC's inspection schedule. It is my understanding that AANDC Inspector Christine Wilson visited the camps in the Kivalliq region in 2012. This inspection comprised of visiting the two sites listed in the Kitikmeot region:

Camp A N65.56 W103.61
Camp E N64.97 W106.06

A site inspection was conducted on July 7, 2013 by Water Resources Inspector Eva Paul, pursuant to the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*.

Consistent with the documentation that was provided to the NWB, it appears that no camps were established at the coordinates listed in the licence and that no water was used and no waste deposited under this licence.

I am satisfied with the information that has been provided and with my findings on-site. Cancellation of the licence is recommended if the NWB is satisfied that administrative requirements have been met.
