RE: Uravan Minerals Inc. ("Uravan") – Water License Amendment Application – Garry Lake Project

Phyllis it would appear that Word2007 was the issue in not being able to open Schedule 1 and 3. I have converted those documents to an older version of Word, they are attached and I trust they are available to you.

The abandonment and restoration plan was addressed in Exploration / Remote Camp Questionnaire and the Uranium Exploration and Fuel Spill Contingency Plans are addressed in Schedules 1 & 3 respectively.

The answer to your question regarding the amendment; yes, this amendment application is to accommodate a larger proposed camp and yes to accommodate diamond drilling. The water quantities consumed in camp and at the drill are stated in the Exploration / Remote Camp Questionnaire; <1.2 m³/day in camp and approximately 90 m³ / drill hole averaged over 5 days per drill hole = approximately 18 m³/day when drill is functioning.

I will proceed with having all pertinent data translated. Thank you for the list of translators.
