The Licensee must provide the following information:

A summary report of water use and waste disposal activities, including, but not limited to: methods of obtaining water; sewage and greywater management; solid and hazardous waste management.

The Heeqou camp was occupied from 16-24 August 2004 by a crew of 10 people. Water was used for showers, drinking, and washing dishes. It was obtained using an on-demand system directly from the lake via a 2-inch waterline and electric pump at a rate of approx. 200gal/day. The intake point for the waterline was located immediately north of the peninsula on which the camp is located. The camp consists of 6 structures: I outhouse, 5 canvas tents (I dry, I kitchen, 3 sleepers). All canvas tents were removed and the wood frames still remain on site.

Sewage was contained in an outhouse, approx 205m from the lakeshore, 5-10m above the water level. Greywater ran into 2 separate sump pits, one each for the dry and kitchen. The sump holes were approx 1m in depth and 2mX2m in area. Sumps were located approx 110m from the lakeshore.

All solid waste that could not be incinerated was removed from the site via aircraft for disposal in Yellowknife.
