## RE: 120911 2BE-SNN0813 Application for Cancellation Qikiqtani Region

Stornoway Diamond Corp. has submitted to the Nunavut Water Board an application for the cancellation of water license 2BE-SNN0813 and its predecessor 2BE-SNN0508. The water license was issued to support the Aviat Project, an exploration joint venture between Stornoway Diamond Cop. and Hunter Exploration Group. Exploration activities, including diamond drilling, occurred between 2005 and 2008 and the site then remained inactive from 2009 through 2011. In 2012 camp demobilization and site remediation activities occurred. Although site remediation activities have occurred, further exploration activities on the property may occur at a later date.
