Re: 2BE-SNN0305 (previously NWB2SNN0305) - Stornoway Diamond Corporation - Aviat Project - 2005 Annual Report Review

On behalf of the Department of Indian Affairs and Norther Development (DIAND), I have reviewed the 2005 Annual Report, submitted by Strongbow Exploration Inc. with respect to the Aviat Project. The Annual report has been assessed with reference to License NWB2SNN0305 (License).

With respect to water quality, the Analytical Report for NWL Number 382278-4, Sample AN260 A, states that Total Suspended Solids (TSS) was 11 mg/L. This value however, is above the Canadian Council of Ministers of the Environments (CCME) Canadian Water Quality Guidlines for the Protection of Freshwater Aquatic Life, of 10mg/L for TSS.

Additionally, the 2005 Annual Report also mentions the burning of combustible refuse. It is unclear if this type of refuse was handled according to Part D, Item 3 of the License. This section of the License states that all combustible waste will be incinerated. Although this may be a composition error, it nonetheless merits investigation into waste disposal methods.

Also, the proponent should updated their Spill Contingency Plan to include Mr. Peter Kusugak, (867) 975-4295 as their INAC contact.
