The Aviat Camp is currently in a winterized/storage state and plans are being put into place to deconstruct the facility, remove all camp related structures, equipment and fuel currently stored on the land use area, and complete the final reclamation activities as per the approved Abandonment and Restoration Plan for the Aviat Project. The deconstruction of the Aviat camp and the completion of the final abandonment and reclamation activities will take place at some point during July and/or August of 2012.

Working concurrently with the reclamation crew will be a group of professional land surveyors who will be conducting the surveying requirements necessary to

to convert a select portion of the existing mineral claims that comprise the Aviat land package to mining leases. Please note that the camp facility will not be used to house personnel conducting these activities as both crews (surveying and reclamation) will be housed at Stornoway's logisitics base in Igloolik. It is estimated that the surveying of the claims, the deconstruction of the Aviat camp and the completion of the abandonment and reclamation activities on the land use area will take approximately six weeks time, in total, to complete. A final land use report accompanied by the additional requisite documentation to close 2BE-SNN0813 will be submitted to the Nunavut Water Board prior to its expiry date of September 30, 2013.
