Please note that Part I, Section 2.d requests a schedule for implementing the Abandonment and Restoration Plan, however as the Aviat Project is still engaged in early stage exploration activities it is not practicable to subscribe to a definitive time schedule for the conclusion of this land use operation.

The Abandonment and Restoration Plan does describe restoration activities that are done on an ongoing or seasonal basis as well as those that will be required once the land use operation is complete and the temporary camp facility is removed and the area restored.
