## LICENCE AMENDMENT No. 1

Licensee:

Pursuant to its authority under Article 13 of the Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, the Nunavut Water Board hereby grants the following license amendment.

The License issued August 6, 2003 shall be amended to include the following:

## PART F: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO DRILLING OPERATIONS

Amend Item 2 No land-based drilling is to be done within thirty (30) metres of the high water mark of any water body unless otherwise approved by the Board.

Drill waste from on-ice drilling shall be removed from the drill site.

Land-based drilling within thirty (30) meters on the high water mark of the water body adjacent to the kimberlite outcrop identified by the Proponent in their submission of August 20, 2003 is approved. All drill waste from the three proposed drill holes shall be removed to a disposal sump located greater than thirty (30) meters from the high water mark of the water body.

Unless otherwise referenced above, all terms and conditions of the License NWB2SNN0305 dated August 6, 2003 still apply.
