2BE-TIM0608 / Trigon Uranium Corporation / IC-TIM Project / Kivalliq Re: Region / Assignment of Licence

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) has reviewed the application for assignment of Water License 2BE-TIM0608 submitted by Trigon Uranium Corporation for the IC-TIM Project. The following advice has been provided pursuant to INAC's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (NWNSRT) and the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development Act (DIAND Act).

Trigon Uranium Corporation is in the process of transferring its interests in the IC-TIM Project to Diamondex Resources Ltd. The IC-TIM Project is a Joint Venture which comprises of Contact Diamond Corporation, Committee Bay Resources Ltd., Indicator Minerals Inc., and now, Diamondex Resources Ltd.

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada supports the licence assignment request submitted by Trigon Uranium Corporation. When assigning the 2BE-TIM0608 licence to Diamondex Resources Ltd., The Board should inform the company representatives that the IC-TIM Project's Spill Contingency and Abandonment and Reclamation Plans will require revisions to reflect changes in the project's management and an update of contacts. Revised copies of these plans should be submitted to the Nunavut Water Board well in advance of the upcoming 2008 exploration season.
