This license expired on September 31, 2008. Abandonment and reclamation activities on the land use area have been completed.			
8. The abandonment and restoration activities completed on the land use area subject to this license were detailed in a letter submitted to the Nunavut Water Board on June 24, 2013.			
Land use for the portion of project located on Crown land (including the camp location) was authorized under INAC Land Use Permit N2004C0010. On July 19, 2010 the Resource Management Officer for the Kitikmeot Region conducted a field inspection on this property and on November 18, 2010 a letter was issued by INAC (now AANDC) granting final clearance for land use permit N2004C0010. Copies of the inspection report and final clearance letter were provided to the Nunavut Water Board on June 24, 2013.			
Land use for the portion on the project located on Inuit Owned Land parcels was authorized by the Kitikmeot Inuit Association under Inuit Owned Land Use License 3 KTL306C010 and Inuit Owned Land Use License 3 KTL304C011. A final land use inspection has been conducted by the Kitikmeot Inuit Association on the land use area subject to these authorizations and final closure has been granted.
