Strongbow Exploration Inc. received correspondence from the Nunavut Water Board dated October 21, 2005 requesting clarification on the following items as reported in the Annual Report for NWB2TRE0406 for the 2004 exploration season (submitted February 8, 2005).

- 1) Camp Locations for 2004 The Nunavut Water Board advised that only one camp location was licensed under NWB2TRE0406, however co-ordinates for 3 fly camps are referenced in the annual report. In the original application associated with NWB2TRE0406 two potential phases of the program are described regarding camp activity. In Phase I a low impact, 3 person fly camp based program is referenced and while the ideal location of 67° 00′ 38″ N, 112° 09′ 30″ W is proposed, it does state that the location may be subject to change as it is dependent on where the majority of the channel sampling, mapping and prospecting will be conducted. The program as described in the 2004 annual report involved low impact, 2 person fly camps that had no impact on the land (See attached photograph "Tree River Project Fly Camp #1"). Less than 0.06 cu.m of water was used per day. The Nunvut Water Board has suggested that an amendment to the license be required, however since this license has an expiry date of April 30, 2006 Strongbow Exploration Inc. will include the co-ordinates of any fly camps proposed for the 2006 and 2007 exploration season in the forthcore.
- **2) Water Use in Cubic Meters -** Water useage in cubic metres for the exploration activities described in the 2004 Annual Report for NWB2TRE0406 was approximately 0.06 cu.m per day.
