Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (AEM)'s Meliadine Gold Project All Weather Access Road was issued a renewed water licence on June 9th, 2015 (date of inspection) by the Nunavut Water Board for the term of ten (10) years.

A regularly scheduled compliance inspection was conducted by WRO WILSON. It was noted during the inspection that the water levels were high due to freshet and heavy rainfall, days prior to the inspection. Phillip ROY, AEM Environmental te4chnicion advised the WRO WILSON that the road was being inspected weekly as per, Part I item 6 of the renewed water licence. The Inspector requested a copy of the AEM inspection report.

Phrase 1 construction of the road is completed for the current purpose of the road is to support the advance exploration activities which are occurring at the mine.

Construction and Operations

- 1. Water was noted; ponding against (photo 1), over topping (photo 2) and washing under misplaced (photo 3a and 3b) or plugged culverts along the road.
- 2. The ponded water was causing erosion to the road especially in areas where the culverts were misplaced and not allowing natural drainage.
- 3. Some sediment was noted in or near water bodies along the side of the road (N $62\,59\,44.4$, W $92\,10\,45.25$)

Spill Contingency Planning

4. As per Part G item 1 "Transportation Spill Contingency Plan for Phase 1 All-weather Access Road between Rankin Inlet and the Meliadine Site" was approved by the Board as part of the renewed water licence, though, it was previously noted in the 2013 and 2014 inspection report that this Plan required revision. It has come to the inspector attention that a more recent Spill Plan has been developed in February for use under this water Licence.

Monitorina

- 5. As per PART I item 1 "Monitoring Plan for Phrase 1 all-Weather Access Road between Rankin Inlet and the Meliadine Site" has been approved by the Board and forms part of this renewed water licence.
- 6. As per PART I item 5 and 6 the inspector has requested a copy of AEM road inspection report for two separate inspections, the first at the beginning of freshet and the report for June 9th, 2015.

 The Licensee will submit the final drafts of the spill contingency plan to relevant regulatory agencies to ensure consistency across all departments.


