## Re.: NxGold Ltd.'s Application for an Approval Without a Licence

Further the Nunavut Impact Review Board's Screening Decision Report issued June 15, 2017, NxGold Ltd. wishes to apply for an Approval Without a Licence from the Nunavut Water Board to conduct the initial program associated with the Kuulu Project (refer to attached application form and translated program summary).

The program purpose is to conduct exploration to assess previously identified gold targets. Exploration activities include:

- Constructing and operating a temporary camp;
- Staking and prospecting;
- Magnetic surveys (airborne and ground), geophysical surveys, boulder and till sampling, geological mapping;
- Archaeological overview and site assessments, where required.

An approval without a licence is being sought to support camp establishment and execution of the studies listed above, requiring the use of <50 m<sup>3</sup>/day of water for domestic purposes, and disposal of greywater and sewage to the tundra. A subsequent application for a Type B water licence will be submitted to support a drilling program.

It is noted that water licence 2BE-PET1114 was previously in place for the property. This licence has not been closed out and reclamation-related items highlighted in the Inspectors' report dated July 29, 2016 remain outstanding. The Applicant undertakes to fulfill the outstanding reclamation related requirements under 2BE-PET1114 as part of the 2017 program.





Further, this letter authorizes Sharleen Hamm of Sharleen Hamm Consulting Ltd. to act as NxGold's representative with regards to the enclosed application and associated licencing and reporting requirements.
