**Re: 3BC-ASM1010 – Cancellation Application – Arctic Shorebird Monitoring – Canadian Wildlife Service**

### **Background**

The Arctic Shorebird Monitoring Program on Victoria Island and King William Island conducted by the Canadian Wildlife Service consisted of 2 camps on both islands. The rapid camp on both islands consisted of 3 people, with the intensive camps supporting 6 and 10 people on Victoria Island and King William Island respectively.

The project duration was two weeks for the rapid survey camps at both locations and four weeks for the intensive survey camps at both locations. All activities at all camps were to have taken place simultaneously.

### **Recommendations/Comments**

The Department of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada, Water Resources Division finds the cancellation application complete with no issues.
