Thanks for your message indicating which outstanding data were missing from our application.

In response to your queries, please consider the following information:

- (1) Camp location: 78°37'01.43" N 74°40'37.02" W
- (2) NPC Conformity: we note that you have set this in motion by cc'ing them on your email response to our application. Thank you.
- (3) Spill Contingency Plan: We bring very little fuel into camp with us (ie <5 gallons of gasoline for a generator; a small propane tank is used for cooking; any helicopter that we use will be based from either Alexander Fiord or elsewhere in the Arctic and will refuel at Alexander Fiord). We will bring a spill kit with us that is issued by the Polar Continental Shelf Program (PCSP) in Resolute.
