The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received on June 7, 2011 and December 12, 2012 the 2010 and 2011 Annual Reports, respectively, from the Geological Survey of Canada as required under the relevant terms and conditions of Licence 3BC-NTC1012, which was issued to the Northeast Thelon Compilation Project on July 21, 2010 and expired on August 30, 2012. The project is situated at multiple locations in the vicinity of the Hamlet of Baker Lake within the Kivalliq Region of Nunavut.

In addition to the above-mentioned reports, the NWB received on September 26, 2012, the document entitled *Northeast Thelon Compilation Report to Baker Lake, Chesterfield Inlet and Rankin Inlet*, which provided details on the scope of activities carried out under the project for specific periods including the timeframe during which the licence was issued.
