







Communication Requirement:

Notify Baffinland Northern Affairs Manager (Nature of request & authorized response)

Log SAR activities the Emergency Response Communication Log

On site Mgr. or designate updates next senior level of Baffinland management as warranted & upon termination of involvement

Operations Manager determines invoice amount for services & forwards to Baffinland Accounts Receivable

Factors Requiring Consideration:

- Baffinland employees & contractors are not trained in SAR. The level of involvement should be restricted to the normal operating capabilities of personnel & equipment
- Weather
- Mary River Project site emergency response capability in the absence of rescue personnel & equipment.
- Contractor equipment release authorization
- Risk of activities associated with the SAR
- Safety of personnel engaged in SAR
