Transport Canada (TC) would like to thank The Government of Nunavut for your review and comments addressed to Nunavut Water Board (NWB) dated May 23, 2006 regarding the above project.

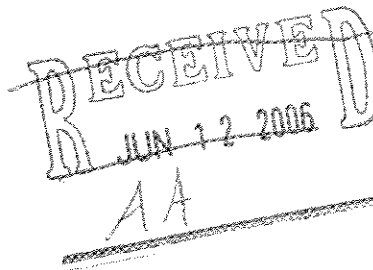
TC will comply with all territorial legislation including (but not limited to) Government of Nunavut *Environmental Guideline for Site Remediation*, *Environmental Guideline for Waste Asbestos*, and *Nunavut Environmental Protection Act*.

Any contaminated soil encountered will be removed and deposited in a licensed land treatment facility. All mitigative measures will be followed as outlined in the water license application to NWB. In addition, any contaminated water will be properly contained and treated.

TC will be removing and containing all asbestos waste as described in the license application with the applicable mitigation measure. Air monitoring will be conducted throughout the project to ensure a safe work environment. The asbestos waste will be removed and shipped to a licensed disposal facility outside of Nunavut.
