RE: Tehery-Wager Geoscience Project – Application for approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence

The Geological Survey of Canada, in collaboration with partners from the Canada-Nunavut Geoscience Office and Canadian universities, is planning on conducting a geoscience project in the Tehery-Wager area in Nunavut. The study area is located north of Chesterfield Inlet and comprises all or parts of eight 1:250 000 scale NTS map sheets. Geological mapping and research will be conducted out of field camps in the summers of 2015 and 2016. Each camp will consist of up to 15 people and have fuel stored on site for use with a helicopter, heating, and cooking.

With this letter, project proposal, and corresponding documents, we would like to apply for approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence and seek NWB's permission to proceed with our planned research during the summers of 2015 and 2016.
